## Nation's Largest Commercial Painting Contractor Opens Denver Office to Cover Mountain Region Company Plans Unique Economic Stimulus Plan

One local Denver business is already on board with the People's Stimulus. Doc's of Denver a carpet and upholstery cleaning company offers their customers a 10% cash discount upon payment, which the customer gets back in \$2 bills.
